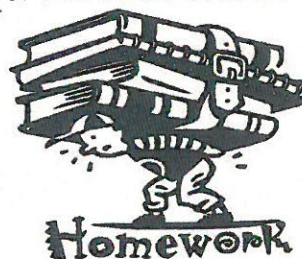
Topic
