Topic

In Art, we will be:

In Maths, we will be:

- Looking at conversion graphs.
- Developing mental methods for calculations
- Calculating the area of triangles
- Working collaboratively on mathematical trails and treasure hunts
- Regular problem solving and reasoning activities with regards to all of the above.

- Programming using Scratch software.
- Understanding safety when using websites.
- Using a variety of software (such as Microsoft power point and excel) to support our project work for the topic.
