Medication

We would like to remind all parents that any medicine that your child needs to take during school hours should be brought to the school office, where it will be locked in the medical room until needed. Please do not send medicine in with your child as we have to log the time of last dose, which needs to be signed for by a parent/guardian.

Medicine should be in the original container with your child's name, and dose instructions clearly marked. We are happy to administer over the counter pain relief such as paracetamol or Ibuprofen but these *must* be age related and we adhere strictly to the instructions on the label as per the manufacturer's instructions.
